Policies & Standard Operating Procedures- Mgt of AIS	There is a system initiative to reduce the number of policies and transfer content to Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) or education materials as appropriate. Currently, we have one system Stroke policy which is a high level overview of the Stroke code process and each delivery network (DN) has DN-specific SOPs that guide practice, due to the variability in Stroke level certification, resources, and structure. A concerted effort is made to maintain a similar structure and outline of the SOPs and standardize across the system as best as possible.  Alyssa Yardis (YNH) has been charged with overseeing system neuroscience policies, which includes Stroke.  A brief review of the Management of Acute Ischemic Stroke SOP reveals updates will be needed to reflect Telestroke services and Thrombectomy Procedures. ## Stroke and Thrombectomy

Wednesday, September 25 Noon - 1 pm Noble Conference Center

Speaker: Charles Matouk, MD, cerebrovascular neurosurgeon, director/endovascular surgery, Yale University/Yale New Haven Hospital



Stroke is a medical emergency that occurs when the blood supply to the brain is interrupted or reduced. Thrombectomy is a procedure to remove a blood clot in the vessels that supply blood and overent to the brain. Hear about the importance of EAST.
