Hello Everyone,
Great news Dr. Meyer has reviewed C 's results and all look great to move forward with the transfer next '
here is your plan:
Today $(5/3)$ and Tomorrow $(5/3)$, – Continue with the same dose of Lupron 10 units per day and Estradiol – 3 tabs twice per day.
$(5/\cdot)$ - Take last dose of Lupron on this day. Continue with the Estradiol tablets as instructed.
evening. This is the intramuscular injection that is administered in the upper outer quadrant of the buttocks, it is more of a hip injection as we discussed. Please alternate sides. You will continue this medication daily up to 12 weeks of pregnancy. Continue same dose of Estradiol tablets. (Continue with your Estradiol tablets and Prenatal Vitamins daily - You will continue these medications until instructed to stop).
J, 5/ Begin Doxycycline (1 tab twice per day – take after breakfast and dinner) and Medrol (1 tab per day – take after lunch). The Doxycycline can make your skin very sensitive to the sun – so we recommend either staying out of the sun for the 4 days you are on the medication or wear sunscreen and protective clothing. This medication can also cause an upset stomach so make sure to eat before you take this medication.

, 5/. We will have you go for **blood work**. These results ensure that you are absorbing all of the medications and determine if we need to adjust any dosages prior to the transfer. We will fax over the orders to your local clinic.

, 5/ Embryo transfer. We will have the time of the transfer 1-2 days prior to the procedure and will send a follow up email with this information.

You will also need to have blood work done on (Estradiol and Progesterone check) and May (Pregnancy Test ©)
