Patient seen by the palliative care team this AM. [redacted] is unresponsive, resting peacefully surrounded by her family and close friends. She is requiring only minimal doses of morphine and ativan for comfort. We are deeply grateful to all involved with granting her final wishes and the support of her family.

Review of Systems
 Unable to perform ROS. Patient unresponsive

Physical Exam
 Constitutional: No distress
 Pulmonary/Chest: Effort normal. No respiratory distress.
 Neurological: She is unresponsive.
 Nursing note reviewed.

Recommendations:
 -Continue morphine 2 mg IV q4H PRN dyspnea/pain
 -Continue ativan 0.5 mg IV q2H PRN agitation/distress
 -Increase frequency or dose of both above if necessary
 -If terminal secretions develop, please add robinul 0.2 mg IV q8H PRN
 -In the unlikely event that she develops terminal agitation, please add haloid 1-2 mg IV q4H PRN based on severity
